## **Buckhorn Reservoir:**

- 1. NO new blinds are to be constructed at the reservoir at Buckhorn Reservoir
  - a. All current blinds may remain, however if destroyed by mother nature or loss of blind permit, may not be rebuilt
- 2. How can I hunt at Buckhorn for Duck Season?
  - a. You can hunt from a temporary blind such as a boat or temporary ground blind
  - b. You can leave a pontoon boat blind in the water from November 1- February 13th
    - i. Use anchors to keep pontoon in place during season
    - ii. Pontoon must be removed by February 13th
- 3. Do not disturb the buffer around the lake in any way
  - a. Do not remove vegetation within the 50 ft buffer around the lake's edge for "brushing up your blind", you need to harvest material off site and bring to your blind
  - b. Do not cut trails through the 50 ft buffer to access your blind location, please minimize your impact on the buffer
  - c. Do not leave trash or debris from temporary blinds within the buffer
  - d. Do not disturb the 50 ft buffer in any way

## Wiggins Mill Reservoir:

- 1. Blinds can continue to be built
- 2. There are no changes to the existing Duck Hunting Regulations listed on the City's Website
- 3. Do not disturb the buffer around the lake
  - a. Do not remove vegetation within the 50 ft buffer around the lake's edge for "brushing up your blind", you need to harvest material somewhere else and bring to your blind
  - b. Do not cut trails through the 50 ft buffer to access your blind location, minimize your impact on the buffer
  - c. Do not leave trash or debris from temporary blinds within the buffer
  - d. Do not disturb the 50 ft buffer in any way
