NOTICE OF USE OF REMOTE COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY AND PUBLIC ACCESS FOR THE JULY 7, 2020 WILSON COMMUNITY FORUM ON COVID-19

Due to the Declared State of Emergency in response to COVID-19, the Wilson City Council has altered the traditional meeting process to accommodate and encourage positive public health practices. In accordance with Session Law 2020-3, Section 4.31, the City is incorporating virtual meeting practices and remote communications technology in order to continue the work of the City Council while taking proactive measures to maintain transparency.

The Wilson City Council will host a Wilson Community Forum on COVID-19 on Tuesday, July 7 from 5:30 p.m. until 6:45 p.m. This will be a virtual event. The public is encouraged to submit their questions to help address topics important to Wilson residents through the City's website prior to the event. Citizens are invited to watch the forum streamed live on the City's website www.wilsonnc.org or on Wilson's Channel 8 on Greenlight and other local cable systems. No direct access to the City's facilities will be allowed.

The event will include a panel of local physicians and public health experts to answer your questions about COVID-19. The panel includes experts from Wilson Medical Center, Wilson County Health Department, Carolina Family Health Centers and area physicians.
