



Grading Permit Application Form

Plan submission - A plan shall be prepared for all land-disturbing activities subject to this article whenever the proposed activity will disturb more than one (1) acre on a tract for residential and one half (0.5) acres for commercial. Two (2) copies of the plan and one (1) digital copy shall be filed with the City of Wilson; a copy shall be simultaneously submitted to the Wilson County Soil and Water Conservation District at least thirty (30) days prior to the commencement of the proposed activity. (Sec. 32.5-6) . Grading permit applications are part of the total erosion control plan submittal

***Any required State and/or Federal permits must be obtained prior to obtaining a grading permit. In order to issue the permit, the following information must be submitted. Permit fee due upon permit issuance.**
