1.0 Purpose

To establish a uniform procedure to be followed in the reinstatement of an employee.

2.0 Policy

An employee resigning in good standing may be reinstated by the City within six-months of the date of resignation.

3.0 Scope

All former full-time employees who resigned in good standing during the preceding six-month period.

4.0 Definitions

- 4.1 <u>Good Standing:</u> The term used to determine whether or not a former full-time employee is eligible to be reappointed to a position within the classification previously held by the employee immediately prior to his/her departure from the City's service. Three (3) conditions must be met:
 - 4.1.1 Gave notice prior to the date of voluntary resignation,
 - 4.2.1 Received a "meets expectations" or higher performance rating on the last performance appraisal received prior to resignation, and
 - 4.3.1 Demonstrated satisfactory personal conduct.
- 4.2 <u>Reinstatement</u>: The re-appointment of a former employee without competitive examination, during the six-month period immediately following his/her separation from City service to a position within the same classification, within the same department, with the same salary and benefits (unless otherwise provided in these rules).
- 4.3 <u>Rehire:</u> The appointment of a former employee to City employment after successfully competing with other candidates during an external selection process.

5.0 Rules/Procedures

- 5.1 An employee may be reinstated by the department head if he/she left the City in good standing during the preceding six-month period.
- 5.2 The reinstated employee may only be reinstated in the same classification at the same rate of pay.
- 5.3 The reinstated employee will maintain his/her seniority and will continue to be eligible for the benefits he/she was eligible to receive prior to departure with the exception of those benefits that are grand-fathered.
- 5.4 Armed forces and National Guard reservists will be reinstated in accordance with Federal regulations.
